He is one of the representatives of the Big 5 accounting firms appointed by the IASB as a member of the IASB-FASB Joint Transition Group for Revenue Recognition, which would advise the IASB and FASB on potential implementation issues that could arise when companies implement IFRS 15.

Andrew was a member of the IFRS Foundation's IFRS Advisory Council up to 31 December 2013, which provides advice on single projects with a particular emphasis on practical application and implementation issues. In 2011, he was an independent member of the Financial Reporting Advisory Board, which advises the UK Government on financial reporting principles and standards in the context of EU-endorsed IFRS. Andrew was also appointed a member of the IFRS Interpretations Committee from 1 July 2016, which interprets the application of IFRS and provide timely guidance on financial reporting issues that are not specifically addressed in IFRS.

Wayne is the BDO International's IFRS leader for the Asia Pacific Region and is a member of BDO International's IFRS Working Party. He was involved in a significant number of IFRS conversions in Australia.
